Women and girls represent only 2.5% of WA state maritime professionals, our goal is to change this! We are offering scholarships to women and girls, transgender, and non-binary individuals.

NORTHWEST MARITIME CENTER EDUCATION PROGRAM SUPPORT: We will provide funds to help sustain Northwest Maritime Center maritime education programs for people of all ages.

WOMEN'S MARITIME ADVENTURER AWARD: This prestigious annual award is designed to provide well-deserved recognition to individuals or teams that have completed maritime adventures with special distinction.

WOMEN'S ADVENTURE FUND: This fund will support women or women-led teams, expeditions, etc., that have an awesome, outrageous plan for adventure.
