## DAY PROGRAMS

Sail or row aboard our teaching vessels or participate in land-based Mariner's skills classes with our experienced maritime educators. Activities aboard the boats include teambuilding and problem solving while learning to sail, row, and navigate. Activities ashore include navigation, compass use, knots, Pacific Northwest maritime history, and boat shop/maritime trades tours. Programs of 2-6 hours in length are available.

Age range: 5 years and up.

## MULTI-DAY PROGRAMS

Sail, row, build-a-boat, and learn maritime skills during 2-5 day intensive programs at the Northwest Maritime Center. Sleep on-site in our spacious meeting rooms and participate in maritime activities including evening programs. Group size of up to 40 students can be accommodated. Other lodging options are available.

Age range: 10 years and older



## VOYAGING

Voyage aboard an historic longboat. Trips of two days or longer around the San Juan islands or Port Townsend are available. Students build cooperative, leadership, and maritime skills on voyages of exploration and discovery.

Age range: 14 and older

## LONGBOATS

Our two longboats are 26 foot historic replicas of the vessels Captain Vancouver used to explore the region. Incredible teambuilding platforms, they are equipped with 8 rowing stations and 3 sails. Up to 10 students and one teacher accompany our USCG licensed Captain and Mate.

## SAILBOATS

We have multiple 26' long sailboats that are simply rigged and are great platforms for learning sailing. They can hold up to 5 students with our experienced instructor.



## BOATBUILDING/BOATSHOP

Groups of up to 5 students can work on one boat. Multiple boats can be built at a time and can be completed in 4-5 days. Shorter programs with hands-on woodworking skills are available.



## PILOTHOUSE SIMULATOR

Learn in our state of the art pilothouse simulator designed to train merchant mariners using modern navigation electronics. Classes include learning to use radar, electronic charts, and helm and engine operation.
